WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBLE TAXI DRIVER TRAINING

Commencing, Thursday 6th July 2017, the Taxi Council will be conducting training of the Wheelchair Accessible Taxi Driver Training Unit "TLIC2040 Provide Wheelchair Accessible Taxi Services to Passengers with Disabilities".

This is an accredited Unit which means drivers who successfully complete the One Day Course, assessments and the on-road shifts, will have that Unit of Competency included on their Education qualification, Certificate II "Driving Operations".

This training will provide drivers with the skills and knowledge necessary to best meet the transport needs of the disabled community who are using Wheelchair Accessible taxis.

Existing Drivers of all general taxis, including wheelchair accessible taxis, are invited to upgrade their taxi driving skills to incorporate this new and important competency based training.

This is a compulsory pre-requisite for Wheelchair Accessible taxi driving. You will be required to complete the training and obtain a Statement of Attainment prior to applying for a Wheelchair Accessible Taxi PIN.

Training will be conducted at the Taxi Council offices at the Adelaide Airport between 9am and 5pm on scheduled days. The first 25 places will be offered free of charge so please contact the Taxi Council as soon as possible.
