CHANGES TO THE APPROACH AT ADELAIDE AIRPORT DROP OFF

Overnight on Wednesday 14th March 2018 traffic calming devices will be installed on the approach to, and in the drop off and pick up areas at Adelaide Airport.

The following changes to your entry to the drop off commence on the 15th March 2018.

Adelaide Airport management has asked that you utilise the outside (right hand) lane on the approach to the drop off and pick up area so that you can provide a faster, more efficient and more convenient service to your passengers.

- Three sets of narrow rubber speed humps will be installed.
- Three separate sections of bollards will be laid between the two through traffic lanes to separate the lanes and to encourage drivers with a knowledge of the drop off and pick up areas of Adelaide Airport to use the right-hand lane when entering under the carpark building.
- The bollards will allow traffic to change lanes and stop to drop off or collect passenger when closer to the lift area. There will be breaks in the bollards to allow traffic to change lanes during periods of low traffic flow. In periods of heavy traffic flow these breaks will be closed to encourage traffic to travel further along the outside (right hand) drop off and pick up area.
- Installation will be completed overnight on 14th March and will be in place for traffic using the area on Thursday 15th March.
