Outer Harbour Cruise Ship Arrivals

Queen Elizabeth Friday 11th November 2022

This ship is a transit coming from international ports. The 1,600 passengers will be mainly day visitors **disembarking from 7:00am** and off for pre-arranged excursions. There will be some free independent travel for the day.

The peak times for passenger movement/ foot traffic will likely be the morning disembarkation period (7-10am).

A reminder to drivers that this is also Pageant day and while visitors to Adelaide might like to see the pageant, there will be traffic restrictions in the City.

There will be no Taxi Council Concierge at this ship - entry is via Gate C

Pacific Explorer, Saturday 12th November 2022

Passengers will start to disembark at around **7.00am** and plenty of Taxis will be needed. The Taxi Council Concierge will be calling the CBSs hoping that they let you know when more taxis are required.

The Pacific Explorer is the only "full turnaround" ship (meaning they have passengers disembarking) but there are another 30 ships arriving during the Cruise season, with thousands of passengers and crew on board.

The Taxi Council Concierge, Kevin, will be at the terminal, entry is via Gate B, Oliver Rogers Road.
